In addition it had a PA422 interface and could be programmed directly from a computer using a RS232-to-PA422 adapter.

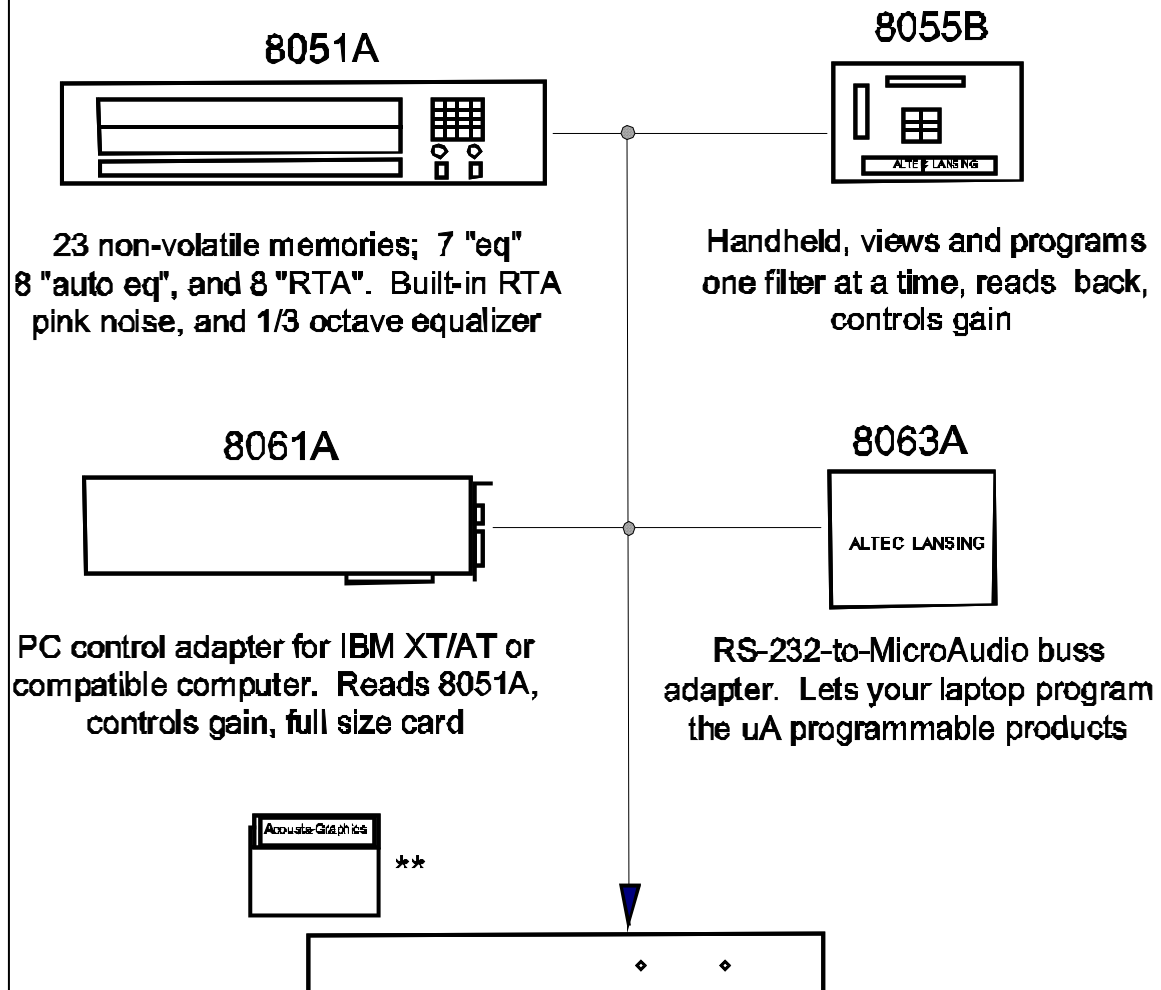
Two models, 8431A and 8432A, were programmed only from a laptop computer. They could be ordered with a PA422 or RS232 interface. The PA422 models require PA422-to-RS232 adapters. I can supply the software for these units.

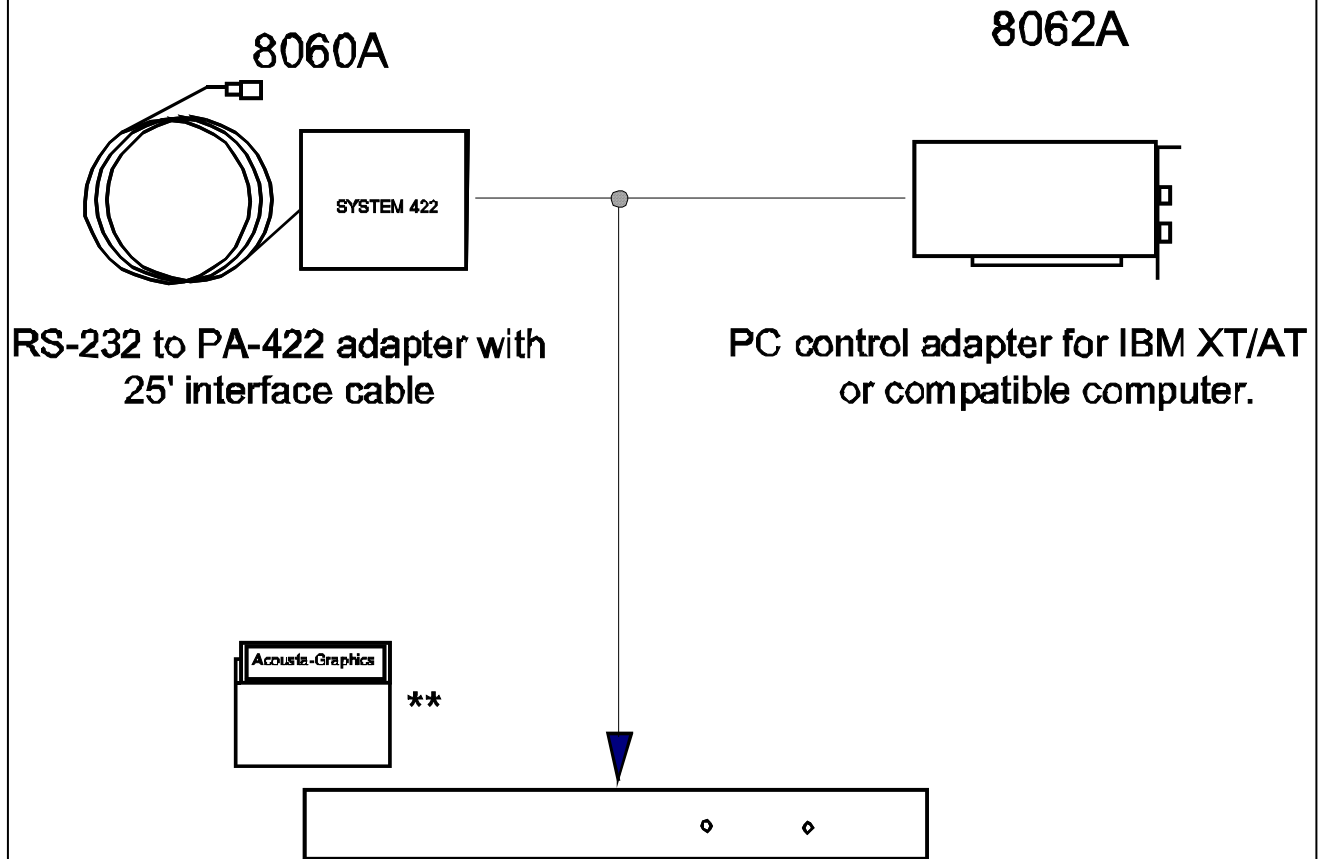
